

Call for Workshop Proposals

IEEE ANTS 2017 plans to host two half-day or full-day workshops and invites proposals that focus on current topics of interest to the networking and telecommunication community. Workshop should include a mix of short / long papers and invited talks and panels. It should encourage active discussion among the participants. Topics of interest include but are not limited to: 5G, Big Data / Analytics, Cloud / Fog Computing, IoT and SDN / NFV and Smart Cities. Accepted and presented workshop papers will be published in the conference proceedings and submitted to IEEE Xplore.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Each ANTS2017 workshop proposal (maximum 5 pages) in a single PDF file must include:

- Name and abbreviation of the workshop
- Length of the workshop: Half-day, Full-day
- A brief description of the technical issues addressed by the workshop and reasons why this area is important in the context of ANTS2017.
- Names and bios (up to 200 words) of Technical Program Committee (TPC) and/or Organizing Committee members
- Names of potential Speakers
- Likely contributors and targeted audience
- The planned format of the workshop, such as number of papers, talks, etc.
- If applicable, a description of past versions of the workshop, including statistics of submitted/accepted papers and attendee numbers.
- Publicity and advertising plan
