TUTORIAL PROPOSAL FORMAT:

The tutorial proposal (maximum 5 pages) should describe concisely the content, importance and timeliness of the tutorial. It should contain the following sections:

1. Title of tutorial
2. An outline of the tutorial content, including its tentative schedule.
3. Names, addresses, and a short biography (up to 200 words) of the instructors.
4. A description of the technical issues that the tutorial will address, emphasizing its importance and timeliness.
5. If appropriate, a description of past versions of the tutorial, including number of attendees should be provided.

TUTORIAL PROPOSAL SUBMISSION:

Submitted tutorial proposal should not exceed FIVE pages and it should be submitted in one all-in-one PDF file. The proposal document should be submitted electronically by email to the tutorial chairs (e-mail given).
